Comments on the operation of the scheme during the year

The Scheme continues to attract consistent support from diagnostic histopathologists in Scotland (\approx 89 participants) and Northern Ireland (\approx 32 participants).

There has been one critical incident and one complaint recorded by the scheme in the last 12 months. The complaint was from a participant with regard to the selection of cases for Circulation 48.

The critical incident involved the dispatch of incorrect slides within Circulation 49, which was quickly dealt with and resolved.

The Quality Manager of the scheme plans to retire in July 2020.

Following a full assessment visit by UKAS in April 2019, our scheme maintains full UKAS accreditation.

The scheme organiser's time is included in the job plan, as is that of the Data Manager.
